Designed by more than 30 clinicians and coders, ProVation MD streamlines the coding and billing process, resulting in greater efficiency, increased profitability and clinician satisfaction. Available in Cath, Peripheral Vascular, Nuclear and Echocardiography sub-specialties, ProVation MD Cardiology completes your documentation workflow by interfacing with other cardiology systems to capture measurements, administrative and procedural data.

Unlike Cardiovascular Information Systems (CVIS), ProVation MD software is a streamlined procedure documentation and coding solution that eliminates the need for physician dictation and utilizes an intuitive physician-designed interface. The ProVation MD Anticipatory Interface[™] is a series of cascading menus that automatically navigate from one section of the procedure note to the next, displaying only relevant content based on previous selections. The software's **DocuDiagrams**[™] feature gives physicians an easy-to-use graphical method to document cardiac findings and interventions as well as the ability to quickly generate complete procedure notes without compromising their ability to elaborate on entries or modify procedures. Cardiology procedure reports can be instantly populated with devices,

medications, measurements and other data from hemodynamic systems. The software also automatically generates letters, orders, requests and patient instructions.

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As part of the electronic documentation process, ProVation MD automatically generates billing codes based off the physician's selections. As a physician makes menu selections, the software's coding engine responds by generating the associated CPT and ICD codes, as well as CCI edits, to ensure proper reimbursement. Once the physician reviews and accepts the codes, the resulting procedure note is ready for fast coder review and sameday billing. Health Information Management (HIM) personnel will realize greater accuracy and productivity as a result of the ProVation coder-ready note, and the software eliminates the back-and-forth between physicians and HIM personnel who require more detail to code correctly. This quick and automatic process will facilitate proper revenue recovery while also offering greater compliance with HIPAA, JCAHO, OIG and other regulations and reimbursement procedures. Updates are delivered quarterly, so clients can be assured their coding program remains current.

Compliance with Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) coding rules is critical not only to ensure accurate reimbursement but to avoid the risk of costly audits. In October 1998, CMS launched the national Recovery Auditor Contractor Program (RAC) in an effort to identify potential payment errors, consolidate fraud detection and prevent waste and abuse in Medicare. ProVation MD software helps to protect against RAC fines by ensuring that professional and facility codes match and documentation supports coding.

Existing CVIS may capture measurements and administrative and procedural data, but the wait for physician dictation and transcription can lead to duplicated paperwork, payment delays and reduced reimbursement. Interfacing with existing CVIS to capture measurements as well as administrative and procedural data, ProVation MD completes the cardiology documentation and coding workflow, speeding up the finalization and availability of electronic patient records, which are accessible to other caregivers and referring physicians immediately following procedures.
