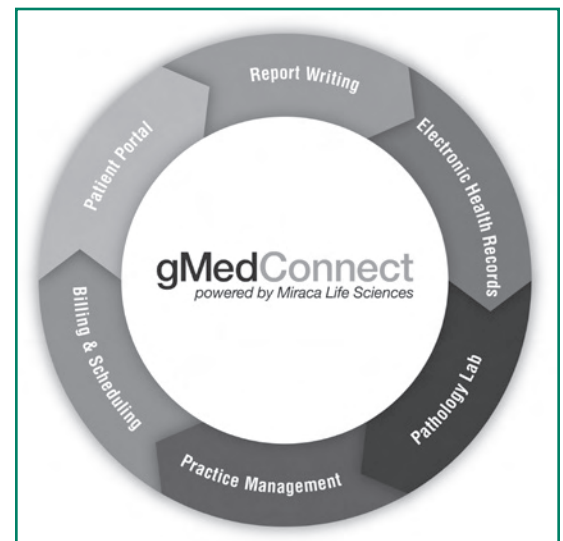

In the Health Affairs' article, *Medical Groups' Adoption Of Electronic Health Records And Information Systems* (September 2005 vol. 24 no. 5 1323-1333), Gans et al. reported data from a nationally representative sample of medical group practices and found that "the process of choosing and implementing an EHR appears to be more complex and varied than we expected. This suggests a need for greater support for practices, particularly smaller ones, in this quest if the benefits expected from EHRs are to be realized."
